

FOREWORD

The Linguistics Circle of the University of Victoria is pleased to present the Proceedings of the Eleventh Northwest Linguistics Conference in this year's volume of its Working Papers (WPLC). The Northwest Linguistics Conference is hosted annually on a rotating basis by the University of Victoria, Simon Fraser University, the University of British Columbia, and the University of Washington. NWLC 11—held at the University of Victoria on February 18th and 19th, 1995—had all four universities well-represented and included presenters from outside the Pacific Northwest. Of the 24 papers presented at the conference, 17 appear in this volume, representing a wide range of topics in linguistics.
